Overview

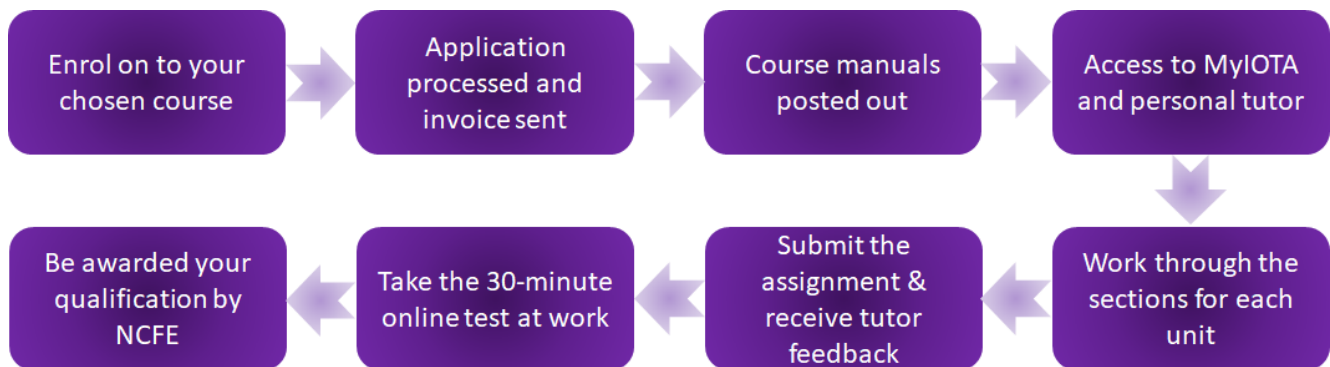

Insight Optical Training Level 2 Supporting Optical Practice FAQs

What is the content?

There are eight units to choose from, so it can be tailored to each individual learner and business. Completing any four units will lead to the Level 2 Certificate, and completing all 8 units will lead to the Level 2 Diploma.

When can I start?

We have start dates throughout the year, so you won't have to wait long before starting.

Start dates can be found on our website, but for 2023 they are 6th February, 6th March, 1st May and 4th September

How much will it cost?

The normal cost is £ 800 for the Level 2 Certificate and £ 1400 for the Level 2 Diploma. Everything you need is included. If you complete the Level 2 Certificate, then you can complete the Level 2 Diploma by paying the £ 600 difference. Interest free payment plans are available on request if you cannot afford to pay for the full fee upfront.

Are there any discounts?

Practice members of SightCare will be given a 10% discount (£ 720 for the Certificate and £ 1260 for the Diploma)

A discount is also available if you are paying for three or more learners at once (they do not have to all start at the same time). Please contact us for more details.

Are there any additional costs?

No. The fee includes everything you will need, from your online access and printed materials, tutor support, the online tests and your printed qualification certificate from NCFE. The only time you will need to pay for anything else is if you fail one of the online tests and need to retake it. The cost of a resit is currently £ 40.

How long does it take?

Each unit is broken down into smaller sections, so, on average, each unit should take 6-8 weeks to complete. You will need to allow time to complete the unit assignment, and to revise for the online test. An average, most of our learners allow 2-3 hours a week for completing their reading and online activities.

How long will I have to finish?

We will provide you with a timetable to help structure your studies and keep you on track. However, we do understand that life and work can sometimes get in the way. Your enrollment will be live for up to 18 months for the Certificate and up to 24 months for the Diploma. If you need longer, then you will need to apply for an extension.

Are there any exams?

Yes. Each unit has a 30 minute online test, which can be taken in the workplace. The pass mark for each of these is 50% and they are monitored by an independent quality assurer to ensure that they are fair and that our processes are robust.

What will I get at the end of the course?

Successful completion of the course will lead to a Level 2 Qualification. You will receive your printed qualification certificate from NCFE to display your achievement.

Can I order the modules for someone else?

Yes. You can order modules for a family member, friend, work colleague, staff members and more. When placing your order, you just need to provide their details.

HOW TO ENROL

You can enrol regardless of academic background, nationality, age, location, gender, religion or occupation; and with the determination to succeed you will gain a qualification which is a Nationally Accredited qualification and recognised throughout the industry.
